Present: Mayor Clark, Commissioners Forshee, Tucker, Merrifield, Denner Clerk Picheo, Atty. Edison, Pioneer News Representative, Mayor Hatcher, Magst. Laswell and 1 guest.

Minutes: Motion to approve January 6th, 2015 minutes with two corrections (3/0 for passing the budget and removing the verbiage Atty. Edison resent a letter regarding the dumpster) was made by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Merrifield; Passed 4/0.

Budget: A copy of the monthly budget statement was handed out. Motion was made to pay February 2015 budgeted bills by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Denner; Passed 4/0.

Chief Reynolds: Explained to the council that he had followed up on a complaint at 3933 Scenic Trail. He also explained that he had worked with the DOT on the traffic light at Preston and Burkland. He also advised the council and residents on several accidents that had occurred at the new intersection.

Old Business: Mayor Clark explained that 3556 Scenic Trail had been cleaned up.

Mayor Clark also explained that the Riley's sign had been changed to the approved sign permit.


Clerk Picheo stated that the city had 21 unpaid tax bills.

Mayor Clark reviewed two estimates to repair drainage concerns at several properties on Burkland and on Scenic Trail. Estimate for Burkland is \$16,685.00 and estimate for Scenic Trail is \$11,200.00. Motion was made by Comm., Tucker to accept the bid for both projects from RHL, was seconded by Comm. Denner; Passed 4/0.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 pm was made by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Merrifield; Passed 4/0.
