Minutes: Motion to approve February 7, 2012 minutes was made by Comm. Merrifield and seconded by Comm. Forshee; Passed 3/0.

Budget: A copy of the monthly budget statement was handed out. Motion was made to pay budgeted March bills by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Allen; Passed 3/0. Motion was made to pay budgeted April bills by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Merrifield; Passed 3/0.

Chief Reynolds: The chief explained that it was a quite month. There were no burglaries and they were keeping an eye on the kids speeding.

Old Business: Mayor Clark gave an update to the council and residents regarding the portable sign at CK's Market. The Mayor explained the sign is now hardwired and anchored down.
