Present: Mayor Clark, Commissioners Forshee, Allen, Duddy, Tucker, Clerk Picheo, a representative from the Pioneer News and 6 guests.

Minutes: Motion to approve the February 2, 2010 minutes was made by Comm. Tucker and was seconded by Comm. Duddy; Passed 4/0.

Budget: A copy of the monthly budget statement was handed out and reviewed. Motion to pay monthly bills was made by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Duddy; Motion Passed 4/0.

Officer's Report: None

Old Business: Mayor Clark led a discussion on the resignation of the city's enforcement/ police officers due to IRS regulations. Atty. Edison stated that a proposal had been made from Pioneer Village to enter into an agreement with Hebron Estates to provide additional police coverage. Atty. Edison explained that the terms of the agreement including hours and pay would remain the same for at least the remainder of the current fiscal year. Clerk Picheo explained to the council that 12 tax bills that had not been paid and a reminder letter would be sent this month.

Mayor Clark led a discussion on selecting the "no solicitation" sign that will be given to each resident. The council decided on print and size. Mayor Clark asked Clerk Picheo to send out an informational letter with the sign enclosed.

New Business: Mayor Clark led a discussion on cancelling the April meeting due to Spring Break. Motion was made to cancel the April 6th meeting by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Forshee; Passed 4/0.

Mayor Clark stated that a special meeting would be held on April 13th to discuss the budget for next fiscal year.
