Minutes: Motion to approve May 5, 2015 meeting was made by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Denner; Passed 4/0.

Budget: A copy of the monthly budget statement was handed out. Motion was made to pay June 2015 budgeted bills by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Merrifield; Passed 4/0.
