Minutes: Motion to approve May1, 2018 minutes was made by Comm. Denner and seconded by Comm. Merrifield; Passed 4/0.

Budget: A copy of the monthly budget statement for May was handed out. Motion was made to pay June budgeted bills by Comm. Denner and seconded by Comm. Forshee; Passed 4/0.

Chief Reynolds: The Chief reported a theft of services at 3700 Scenic Trail , Peace of Mind renovations never showed up to do other work they were paid to do. The Chief also reported that 2 people about the cars being parked on the street. Motion was made to cancel July meeting due to national holiday by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Denner; Passed 4/0.
