**Minutes:** Motion to approve May 3, 2016 minutes was made by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Forshee; Passed 4/0.

**Budget:** A copy of the monthly budget statement for May was handed out. Motion was made to pay June's budgeted bills by Comm. Denner and seconded by Comm. Forshee; Passed 4/0.

**Chief Reynolds:** The Chief reported on a man found in the Girl Scout camp and also addressed a party on Scenic Trail where shots were fired.

Chief Reynolds chased a four wheeler around in sub division but lost him. Also spoke to car lot regarding transport truck coming into subdivision and turning around. The Chief reported on CK's Market, who called to request police one night and then the next night requested an ambulance (possible nervous breakdown).

**Old Business:** Mayor Clark gave an update that Reid Brothers sealed Ruby and Jerry and Jerry  
Comm. Tucker asked council to get bids for next garbage agreement.

Council reviewed pictures of Calhoun's property concerning clean up.

Atty. Edison gave the second reading on Ordinance 2016-04 Budget July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017. Motion was made to accept the budget by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Denner; passed 4/0.



Comm. Tucker made a motion to pay \$1500.00 at one time, seconded by Comm. Denner; Passed 4/0.
