**Minutes:** Motion to approve the November 1, 2011 minutes was made by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Forshee; Passed 4/0.

**Budget:** A copy of the monthly budget statement was handed out. Motion was made to approve the budget was made by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Allen; Passed 4/0.

Chief Reynolds: The chief reported on 3 break-ins that had happened since the last meeting. Two were on Scenic Trail and the other was on Garden Court. Chief Reynolds said that an investigation was under way and there could be as many as two persons of interest.

Old Business: Mayor Clark gave an update to the council and residents regarding the Notebook Learning case. He explained that Notebook Learning had 30 days to remove the POD / trailer. The deadline to have it removed is 17/23/11.

The Mayor told the council that Mr. Hayes has filed for bankruptcy again. According to the city's notifications this will be his 2nd or 3rd time to file for bankruptcy.

Clerk Picheo explained that the city had received payment for 343 tax bills out of 409. A total of 66 are not paid.

Comm. Forshee asked, if anyone attended the last sewer meeting. Mayor Clark said that it was cancelled.

New Business: Mayor Clark read Inter-Local Agreement Resolution. Motion was made to accept the Inter-Local Agreement solution was made by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Merrifield.

A resident raised a concern about the sewer proposal. He explained that the cost of \$15,000 or \$20,000 to be forced into was a lot of money. Mayor Clark stated that he understood his concern was voicing the same concerns with other city and county leaders. The Mayor explained that the schools are in favor of having a sewer. Mayor Clark told the residents that he would keep them informed of any details.
