

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-05

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES ON PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANIES AS OF JANUARY 1, 2001.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Hebron Estates, Bullitt County, Kentucky as follows:

SECTION ONE: That an ad valorem tax of .106 cents on each \$100.00 of value of all property in said City, of public service companies taxable for municipal purposes which are assessed by the Department of Revenue, is hereby levied for the year 2001 as of January 1, 2001.

SECTION TWO: Said levy is made for the purpose of raising revenue to pay salaries of officers and employees; for repair and maintenance of streets, public ways, and public buildings in said city; to pay for lighting city streets; and to pay all proper charges and legal demands against the city.

SECTION THREE: Provisions of Ordinance No. 2001-04 as to method of collection and enforcement shall apply to the tax levied herein.

SECTION FOUR: The Clerk is directed to advertise this Ordinance as provided by law.

SECTION FIVE: Should the actual cost of preparation and mailing of any tax bill exceed the amount of the actual bill, not including penalty and interest, the City Clerk shall not be required prepare and/or mail that specific bill.

SECTION SIX: All payments of taxes provided for herein shall be made to the City Clerk/Treasurer at the business offices of the City of Hebron Estates, 3394 Burkland Blvd., Shepherdsville, Kentucky 40165.

SECTION SEVEN: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION EIGHT: Any ordinance or part of an ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.
