

CITY OF HEBRON ESTATES MEETING

*April 3* - MAY 1, 2001

PRESENT: COMM. FRALEY, MUIR, TUCKER, MAYOR RICKETTS, CLERK FERGUSON, ATTORNEY  
JASON, STATE REP BELCHER. ABSENT COMM. MURPHY, AND PLANNING AND ZONING  
GERALD BURKE

MINUTES: MOTION WAS MADE BY COMM. FRALEY AND SECONDED BY COMM. TUCKER TO  
APPROVE THE MINUTES AS PRESENTED. PASSED 3/0.

BUDGET: MOTION WAS MADE BY COMM. MUIR AND SECONDED BY COMM. FRALEY TO PAY  
THE REGULAR BILLS. PASSED 3/0.

OLD BUSINESS: MAYOR GAVE A REPORT ON HIS FINDINGS OF THE PROPOSED CITY BUILDING  
APPROX 1500 SQ. FT. WOULD COST APPROX. 70-80,000.00. ATTORNEY INFORMED  
THE COMMISSIONERS THAT ANYTHING ABOVE 20,000 WOULD HAVE TO BE BID.  
COMMISSIONER FRALEY WAS CONCERNED ON SPECIFICS SUCH AS WHO WOULD  
MAN THE BUILDING AND HOW MANY HOURS IT WOULD BE OPEN. ATTORNEY  
EDISON GAVE EXAMPLE OF A CITY THAT IS OPEN 4 HRS. A DAY; THAT CITIZENS  
EXPECT SERVICES; THERE WILL BE UTILITY BILLS AND MAINTENANCE. MAYOR  
SUGGEST THAT WE GET THE BUILDING BUILT AND THEN DECIDE THE SPECIFICS.

ATTORNEY REPORTED THAT THE COURT DATE FOR THE LAWSUIT IS JUNE 6, 2001.

DELINQUENT TAX BILLS WILL BE SOLD AT THE MAY 1 MEETING.

NEW BUSINESS: FIRST READING OF THE BUDGET FOR 2001-2002 WILL BE MAY 1, 2001.

MAYOR REPORTED THAT THE CITY WILL BE RODE AND VIOLATIONS WILL BE  
MAILED. ALL PROPERTY IN THE CITY WILL BE MAINTAINED. COMM. MUIR HAD  
SPECIFIC REQUESTS FOR THE VIOLATIONS.

COMM. MUIR MOVED THAT WE ADJOURN; SECONDED BY COMM. FRALEY PASSED 3/0.
