

CITY OF HEBRON ESTATES MEETING
APRIL 22, 1997

PRESENT: COMMISSIONERS CLARK, FRALEY, HANSEN, RUSSELL, MAYOR RICKETTS, CLERK FERGUSON, ATTORNEY EDISON, TOM BARR-PIONEER NEWS, AND THIRTY ONE GUESTS.

MINUTES: A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMM. FRALEY TO APPROVE THE MINUTES SECONDED BY COMM. CLARK. MOTION PASSED 4/0.

BUDGET: A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMM. HANSEN TO PAY THE ROUTINE BILLS; SECONDED BY COMM. CLARK; MOTION CARRIED 4/0.

OLD BUSINESS: FOLLOWING THE SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE 97-02 REGARDING THE FY96 DELINQUENT TAX BILLS; THE 1996 TAX BILLS WERE OFFERED FOR SALE. COMM. HANSEN MOVED THAT THE CITY PURCHASE THE DELINQUENT BILLS AND THAT THE CITY CLERK PLACE LIENS IN THE BULLITT CO. CLERK'S OFFICE. MOTION SECONDED BY COMM.FRALEY; MOTION PASSED 4/0.

COMM. HANSEN PRESENTED A CONTRACT FOR NEW SIGNS AND POSTS. ATTORNEY EDISON WILL REVIEW IT AT THE REQUEST OF THE MAYOR. MS. FERGUSON STATED SHE CANNOT PAY FOR THE SIGNS WITHOUT AN OFFICIAL INVOICE. COMM. HANSEN WANTS THE TAX EXEMPT NUMBER, HOWEVER MS. FERGUSON HAS NOT HEARD FROM FRANKFORT.

FOLLOWING MUCH DISCUSSION REGARDING THE PARKING ON THE STREET, THE MAYOR SAID HE WILL SURVEY THE STREETS AND CHECK INTO WHAT CAN BE DONE.

MS. FERGUSON IS CONCERNED OVER PHONE CALLS THE CITY HAS RECEIVED ABOUT ANIMALS ON THE STREETS. THERE IS A COUNTY ORDINANCE WHERE ALL ANIMALS ARE TO BE IN A FENCE OR ON A LEACH. SHE FEARS THAT SOMEONE MAY GET HURT.

NEW BUSINESS: SGT. RODNEY HOCKENBERRY WITH BULLITT CO. SHERIFFS DEPT., PRESENTED INFORMATION ON THE BLOCK WATCH PROGRAM. THE VIDEO WAS MOST INFORMATIVE. HE DEFINED THE BLOCK WATCH AS THE LINE OF COMMUNICATION TO THE POLICE. FOLLOWING THE PRESENTATION CHRISTINA MUIR VOLUNTEERED TO BE THE CHAIRPERSON FOR HEBRON ESTATES. THE COMMISSIONERS WERE IN GENERAL CONSENSUS FOR HER DO THIS. BLOCK WATCH SIGNS WILL BE PURCHASED AT \$20.00 EACH. SHE WILL GET A LIST OF NAMES AND PHONE NUMBERS OF PARTICIPANTS AND WE WILL HAVE ANOTHER MEETING.

IT WAS ANNOUNCED BY THE MAYOR THAT THE CITY OF HEBRON ESTATES WILL NOT CUT THE GRASS ON LOTS ON 80,81,82 UNTIL THE PROPERTY IS DEEDED TO THE CITY.

COMM. HANSEN MOVED THAT WE ADJOURN ; COMM. FRALEY SECONDED AND MOTION CARRIED 4/0.
