BUDGET: MOTION MADE BY COMM. FRALEY AND SECONDED BY COMM.
MUIR TO PAY THE BILLS; MOTION PASSED 4/0.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMM. MUIR FOR THE CITY OF HEBRON ESTATES
TO PURCHASE THE 2000 DELINQUENT TAXES SINCE NO ELSE WAS
INTERESTED. MOTION SECONDED BY COMM. MURPHY AND PASSED 4/0.

COMM. MILDRED FRALEY GAVE THE FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE 2001-01
REGARDING THE 2001-2002 BUDGET. SHE THEN LED A DISCUSSION ON THE
SUBJECT OF THE CITY BUILDING AND/OR CLERK OFFICE. MS. FERGUSON ASK
THE COMMISSIONERS TO STUDY ALL OPTIONS AND CONSIDER THE MONEY
IN THE GENERAL ACCOUNT. SHE EXPLAINED THAT IF YOU CONTINUE TO
COLLECT TAX MONEY YOU MUST GIVE THE PROPERTY OWNERS SOMETHING
FOR THEIR MONEY. SHE ASK THE COMMISSIONERS TO SURVEY THEIR
AREAS ; MAKE DECISIONS BASED ON ALL THE PROPERTY OWNERS SINCE
EACH COMMISSIONER WAS ELECTED BY THE PEOPLE TO SERVE THE ENTIRE
CITY. CLERK FERGUSON REMINDED THE COMMISSIONERS SHE WAS
PROMISED AN OFFICE IN 1993 AND SHE WANTS THE OFFICE OUT OF HER
HOUSE BY JULY 1, 2001.

COMM. FRALEY AND TUCKER HAD RECEIVED COMPLAINTS ABOUT SOAPY
WATER ON PAULA LANE. THE MAYOR ADVISED THE PROBLEM IS NOT A CITY
PROBLEM, AND MOSQUITOS PROBLEM NEEDS TO BE TAKEN CARE OF BY THE
HEALTH DEPT.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMM. FRALEY AND SECONDED BY COMM.
