

CITY OF HEBRON ESTATES MEETING  
AUGUST 24, 1999

PRESENT: MAYOR RICKETTS, COMMISSIONERS FRALEY, HANSEN, MURPHY, RUSSELL, CLERK FERGUSON, ATTORNEY EDISON, GERALD BURKE, PLANNING & ZONING REPRESENTATIVE, MR. BARR PIONEER NEWS, ED BLEEMEL MAGISTRATE AND TWO GUESTS.

MINUTES: A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMM. FRALEY TO APPROVE AS PRESENTED; SECONDED BY COMM. HANSEN; PASSED 4/0.

BUDGET: MOTION MADE BY COMM. RUSSELL AND SECONDED BY COMM. MURPHY TO ACCEPT THE BUDGET REPORT AND PAY THE BILLS AS PRESENTED. MOTION PASSED 4/0.

OLD BUSINESS: NONE

NEW BUSINESS:

COMM. HANSEN PRESENTED ALL THE OFFICIALS A BOOKLET ON THE KRS LAWS PERTAINING TO OUR CITY. HE WILL GIVE US ADDITIONS TO BE ADDED TO IT EACH MONTH.

ATTORNEY EDISON PRESENTED LAST YEARS REAL PROPERTY TAX RATE CALCULATION WORKSHEET. BASED ON CALCULATIONS OUR TAX RATE WILL BE MUCH LESS BECAUSE OF APPROX. 20-25% INCREASE FROM THE PVA ASSESSMENTS. FOLLOWING THE ATTORNEY HELD THE FIRST READING OF ORD. 99-02 1999-2000 TAX RATE.

CLERK FERGUSON REPORTED THAT SEVERAL RESIDENTS HAVE QUESTIONED HER ABOUT US ADDING POLICE. COMM. FRALEY THINKS WE SHOULD TAKE TURNS AND CALL POLICE IF SOMETHING IS GOING ON SO WE DON'T WASTE TAX DOLLARS. COMM. RUSSELL SUGGESTED THAT RESIDENTS INSTALL MOTION LIGHTS. MR. FREY DON'T AGREE WITH RAISING TAXES. MAYOR RICKETTS FEELS WE ALREADY HAVE POLICE PROTECTION WHEN WE CALL THEM AND WE DON'T NEED TO PAY FOR SOMETHING WE ALREADY HAVE. A DISCUSSION WAS FOLLOWED ON WHERE ARE THE PARENTS? APPARENTLY VANDALISM IS ON THE RISE WITH SWIMMING POOLS, FLOWER POTS, TREES, EGGS & ETC.

MR. BLEEMEL REPORTED THAT THE TURNING LANE AT E. HEBRON LANE AND PRESTON MAY BE A GO THROUGH MR. BELCHER, STATE REPRESENTATIVE.

MR. FREY, RESIDENT DISCUSSED A VOLUNTEER FIREMAN GOING OUT OF CITY AT APPROX 60 MILES AN HR. HE WILL TALK TO THE CHIEF. HE ASK ATTORNEY IF HE CAN GO AND COMPLAIN TO WALT SHOLAR, COUNTY ATTORNEY.

MR. FREY QUESTIONED DUMPSTERS THAT ARE NOT ENCLOSED. SEPT. 9 IS THE DEADLINE.

COMM. HANSEN ASK IF THE RESIDENTS COULD BE NOTIFIED WITH THE TAX BILLS THAT NEXT YEAR IS THE ELECTION FOR THE COMMISSIONERS.

IT WAS GENERAL CONSENSUS IF THE PROPERTY OWNERS HAVE QUESTIONS ABOUT THE CITY THEY SHOULD COME TO THE MEETINGS.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMM. HANSEN AND SECONDED BY COMM. FRALEY TO ADJOURN. PASSED 4/0. NEXT MEETING WILL BE SEPT. 28, 1999.
