Minutes of the September 7, 1993, City Commissioners' Meeting

PRESENT: Commissioners Ricketts (acting as Mayor ~~Proctor~~), Marshall and Fraley, John Wooldridge, City Attorney and Kristina Muir, City Clerk.

GUESTS: Tom Barr of the Pioneer News, 2 residents, George Reidling and Jane Cowan

Old Business: The minutes of the August meeting were read by the City Clerk. A motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Commissioner Fraley, seconded by Commissioner Marshall, vote taken passed unanimously.

A motion to pay all bills was made by Commissioner Marshall, seconded by Commissioner Fraley, vote taken, passed unanimously.

The City Clerk informed us that the tax rate will remain the same as last year.

Commissioner Marshall asked for a listing of residents living on Burkland Blvd. so that he could send a letter to them asking if they would or would not like to have sidewalks installed.

Two stop signs on Garden Court are broken, and there is one badly bent pole for street sign. Commissioner Ricketts said that he would look into having them fixed or replaced.

New Business: None

Open Discussion: Mrs Cowan brought up the problem of drainage off of Burkland Gardens onto Hebron Lane and that a lot of dirt has washed into the culvert and stopped it up. She also asked about the roads that will be back on her property after the development and who would be responsible for maintaining them. She was told by the City Attorney that 1 year after the road was built (to County specifications) the City of Hebron Estates would take them over and maintain them.

With no further business to discuss, the motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Fraley, seconded by Commissioner Marshall, vote taken, passed unanimously.
