Special Meeting September 27, 2004

Present: Mayor Clark, Commissioners Tucker, Forshee, Clerk Hurst, and Attorney Edison and 5 guests and 4 representatives from the garbage companies.

New Business: Comm. Tucker made a motion to move the city meetings to 3407 Burkland Blvd. Comm. Forshee 2nd the motion to approve the motion. Atty Edison read ordinance 2004-05 changing the meeting place for the City of Hebron Estates. Comm. Tucker made a motion to move the meetings to 3407 Burkland Blvd. Comm. Forshee 2nd the motion. 2/0 passed.

Atty Edison read the bid for Dixie Sanitation however, they chose not to bid.

Atty Edison read the bid for Echo Tech which stated that the garbage pick up would be on Fridays 4 cans or 4 bags limit per pick up. The cost would be \$8.25 for one pick up and \$14.50 for Tuesday and Friday's. Plastic containers maybe rented for \$1.50 per tote to add to the monthly bill as an option. Recycle on a once per week base. Recyclable materials include newspapers, aluminum cans and plastic bottles. Monthly charge for recycling would be \$4.00 a month. Bill will be sent out on a quarterly basis however, any property owner who pays in advance will be given a discounted price of \$7.00 will be given.

Atty Edison read the bid from Goodman Service back door service to senior citizens or disabled residents. No can or bag limit, one large item per week. Recyclable is available for additional charge of \$2.50 a month and a one time fee of \$6.00 for the plastic container that will be belong to the resident, \$11.00 per resident for pick up once a week on Monday. Missed collections will be picked up within 24 hours.

Atty Edison read the bid from Rumpke. Residential rates based on a two year contract, billing will take place three months at a time: \$8.25 2 times a week \$14.25., based on a four year contract year 1 & 2 - \$8.25 year, 3 & 4- \$8.75 1&2-yrs 2 times a week \$14.25, 3&4 yrs \$14.25. Commercial rate attached. A Rumpke 95 gallon container will be present upon request an additional one may be leased for additional \$2.50 per month. Prescribed containers are not required and recycling price is once a week 1 yr contract \$1.50 yr 2 &3 \$1.75. Payment will be billed to the residents. Schedule Rumpke pickup will be on Monday from 7:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. During a holiday pick up will be on the next day. No limit on cans however, weight can not exceed 75 pounds.

Atty Edison read the bid from ID (Industrial Disposal). No bid without cart. Once a week service 2 yr \$17.25, 4 yr \$16.75 with cart only -90 gallon size only. Optional recycling with a charge of \$3.25 will require 50% participation from the residents. Yard Waste will be \$4.25 with 50% participation. Commercial attached rate attached. Billing will be on a quarterly basis.

Atty Edison read the bid from Waste Management. One time per week \$9.15 per month, recycling \$5.25 per resident with a cart rental \$2.50 per resident. Rate for two years with a negotiable rate after two years. Commercial rate are enclosed with bid. Billing will be quarterly and payment can be accepted annually. Resident may suspend their service for a period of three months. Waste Management will pick up one junk item per week. Can limit of 4 per household however a person may have 6 we may take that into consideration.

Mayor Clark asked the reps about no charge for garbage pick up for the city hall and furnishes the cart. All reps agreed. Mayor Clark asked Rumpke if they were furnishing one 95 gallon tote and they said they would pick up any other acceptable traditional garbage can. Comm. Tucker asked if Rumpke had liners for the cans and the Rumpke rep stated that he didn't know however, he would get him one if he need to.

Mayor Clark asked the reps "does anyone leakage of fluids from their trucks"? All stated that all trucks leak no truck is water tight. Mayor Clark asked when you could start and they all stated that they could start immediately. Clerk Hurst stated that she can provide addresses for whoever gets the bid. Clerk Hurst asked if their was a limit on the cans. Mayor Clark stated that Waste Management did have a can limit. Clerk Hurst asked Scott with Rumpke and he stated "that we are one of the most flexible around we pretty much take anything". Comm. Forshee asked if Rumpke only pickup on Monday and they stated yes. Clerk Hurst also asked Rumpke who are some of your existing customers and he stated Shepherdsville. Clerk Hurst asked Waste Management who they pick up and they stated Fox Chase and Mt. Washington and Clerk Hurst asked ID and they stated Middletown, J Town, Lake Forest and Mr. Goodman explained that he pickup in E-Town. Clerk Hurst asked all the reps about the bond and they all stated that it would not be a problem.

Mayor Clark opened the floor to the residents. A concerned resident stated that he just wanted to be clear of the prices Waste Management is \$9.15 and Rumpke charge is \$8.25. A resident spoke up and stated that he personally liked Monday's due to the parties and yard clean up that takes place over the weekend and that way you did not have to wait 3 more days to get rid of the trash. A concerned resident asked is their additional cost after the 2 year contract? Comm. Tucker explained that according to Waste Management we would have to negotiate the charge. The resident stated then I guess that means that there is no reason to have more than a two year contract with waste Management. Mayor Clark asked the council if they wanted to wait until the next meeting and they stated yes. Motion was made to adjourn by Comm. Forshee and seconded Comm. Tucker; passed 2/0.
