**Present:** Mayor Clark, Commissioners Duddy, Forshee, Tucker, Clerk Picheo, Atty Edison, Officer Wilson, Tom Barr of Pioneer News and 6 guests.

**Minutes:** Motion to approve the September 6, 2005 minutes was made by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Tucker; Motion Passed 3/0.

**Budget:** Clerk Picheo explained that the city did reclaim all our lien monies from 3511 Burkland Blvd which totaled more than \$1300. Motion to approve the budget was made by Comm. Duddy and seconded by Comm. Forshee; Motion Passed 3/0

**Old Business:** Comm. Forshee stated that he is still working on compiling bids for the community center's new sign. He explained that the latest price on the sign construction was \$1145 and the labor would be the same cost as the sign.

Mayor Clark stated that the Burke's property had been mowed.

Clerk Picheo stated that she spoke with Adam (the owner of American Built Homes) about his dumpster enclosure. He explained to her that he would fix the enclosure temporarily and hopefully by this winter he would have a permanent fix.

**New Business:** Clerk Picheo stated that the tax bills would be mailed out this month.

Guest complained about a letter that he received in his mailbox regarding his camper that is parked in his driveway and he wanted to know why the city sent him the letter. Mayor Clark and Comm.
