OLD BUSINESS: ATTORNEY EDISON REPORTED THAT HE HAD TALKED WITH RHONDA WELCH, MANAGER OF HEBRON CEMETARY AND AS SOON AS THE WEATHER IMPROVES SHE WILL GET THE HEBRON CEMETARY FENCE CLEANED OUT ENTIRELY.

THERE WAS A DISCUSSION REGARDING A VEHICLE ON E. HEBRON LANE WITH FLAT TIRES. MAYOR RICKETTS WILL CONTACT THE INDIVIDUAL PROPERTY OWNER.
