Invocation: James Tucker All Recited the Pledge of Allegiance

✚ City Clerk McCauley read the regular meeting minutes from February 1, 2022. James Tucker made a motion to accept the regular meeting minutes as read. Robert Denner 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

✚ James Tucker made a motion to accept the financial report for February 28, 2022. Russell Forshee 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried

OLD BUSINESS

✚ Clerk McCauley advised there are 11 parcels with 8 owners who have 2021 Taxes in delinquent status. James Tucker inquired about the Legacy Properties. Attorney Edison said B & D Inc is in foreclosure and the city will get paid through the foreclosure.

✚ Attorney Edison read the 2nd reading of Ordinance 2022-03 – Amend FY 2021-2022 Budget to add ARPA Funds. Robert Denner made a motion to accept Ordinance 2022-03 – Amend FY 2021-2022 Budget to add ARPA Funds. Russell Forshee 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

✚ Attorney Edison read the 1st Reading of Ordinance 2022-04 Impose Payment of License Fee 5% on Insurance Companies and remove additional of 5% premium. Attorney Edison explained the County is supposed to reduce their Ordinance back to 5% effective 7/1/2022. Robert Denner said if County does not reduce the 5% the City will not either.

✚ Mayor Clark and City Clerk McCauley will be absent for the April 5th meeting. Robert Denner made a motion to cancel the meeting for April 5, 2022. James Tucker 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

COUNCIL BUSINESS

✚ Mayor Clark spoke with an engineer about Garden Ct having a crack across the road. The engineer will come out when the weather is better to drill a core to see what is under the road.

POLICE BUSINESS

✚ Robert Denner asked Chief Reynolds if people who get stopped get a ticket/fine. Chief Reynolds said yes.

- ✚ Robert Denner would like to see Pioneer Village Police running radar on Burkland Blvd and Hebron Ln.
- ✚ Mayor Clark stated CK's Market & Gas is open but still waiting on their Sunoco gas pumps to arrive.
- ✚ Chief Reynold's February report includes some of the 152 calls for service to the Pioneer Village Police Department:
 - 2/5 on Scenic Trl – report of male in cardiac arrest. He was taken to the hospital.
 - 2/7 on Faro Ct – report of a loud person. Officer told them to hold it down.
 - 2/10 on Burkland Blvd – report of a suspicious white Camry pulled in driveway. The caller said it may be stolen. Vehicle was gone when Officer arrived.
 - 2/15 on E Hebron – report of a teacher's card being keyed.
 - 2/18 on Scenic Trl – report of a 75year-old male not breathing and unresponsive. Male did pass away.
 - 2/2/8 on Burkland Blvd – report of disorderly child. Due to circumstances the child was take to UL Peace Hospital
 - There are three more weeks of DARE. Graduation is set for March 25th at 2:30pm at Freedom Elementary School.
 - April 29th will be the mock crash at North Bullitt High School. This is to discourage seniors from driving under the influence.


PUBLIC BUSINESS


ADJOURNMENT


