- ⚡ James Tucker made a motion to allow resident Gerald Flores to permanently add a storage container on his property in accordance with Ordinance 2007-01. Robert Denner 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried. The resident provided documentation of the type of container and a map of his property where it will be placed.
- ⚡ Attorney Edison explained the 2023-2024 Proposed School Resource Officer Agreement with BCPS and Pioneer Village.
